
### HOLIDAY SPACE FOR RENT

## PUBLIC WASHROOMS IN OUR CITY

A number of community organizations are looking for feedback on the topic of access to public washrooms in Saskatoon, and they welcome hearing from Downtown businesses.

A **Saskatoon Public Washroom Advisory Committee** is working on issues related to access, safety, and ensuring the appropriate number of public washrooms exist, with a 24/7/365 model. This does not mean that every washroom is open 24/7/365 – but is a process to look at infrastructure and determine how and when to use it more effectively and what gaps may exist. The Advisory Committee would like to hear your ideas and determine where the potential is to create this network of washrooms.

## SPROAT STILL COUNTING

From inscribed stones to plaques on benches and everything in between, Meewasin is pleased to help residents find ways to memorialize their loved ones in the Meewasin Valley. When Dean expressed a wish to remember his beloved late wife Diana Sproat, an avid marathon runner who loved the trails + a long-time math consultant and teacher, a state-of-the-art **trail counter** never before seen in Saskatoon only made sense.

The trail counter was **placed in River Landing under the Sid Buckwold Bridge** in the Spring of 2021. With the ability to differentiate, it counts both pedestrians and cyclists.

A small dedication event will be held at the site of the counter on November 12, 2021 at 4:30 PM. Applicable COVID restrictions will be followed.

## NOVEMBER CONSTRUCTION THROUGHOUT THE DISTRICT

Prior to water main work at each of these locations, City of Saskatoon will issue a construction notice to adjacent businesses.

**21st Street East from 1st Avenue South to 3rd Avenue South** - Started **November 9th** for approximately 7 days barring weather delays and unforeseen circumstances (see attached construction notice that will be delivered tomorrow to adjacent businesses). During this work:

- Water services to adjacent businesses are not anticipated to be affected.
- The road will be closed to traffic and access to adjacent parking will be restricted.
- The sidewalk will remain open to pedestrians.
- Once the water main maintenance work is complete the road will be repaired and will be reopened to traffic.

**20th Street East from Idylwyld Drive South to 1st Avenue South** - Anticipated to begin **November 18th** for approximately 10 days barring weather delays and unforeseen circumstances. During this work:

- Water services to adjacent businesses are not anticipated to be affected.
- The road will remain open to traffic, however, there will be lane restrictions in place.
- The sidewalk will remain open to pedestrians.

**2nd Avenue South from 20th Street East to 21st Street East** – Anticipated to begin **November 22nd** for approximately 10 days barring weather delays and unforeseen circumstances. During this work:

- Water services to adjacent businesses are not anticipated to be affected.
- The road will be closed to traffic and access to adjacent parking will be restricted.
- The sidewalk will remain open to pedestrians.
