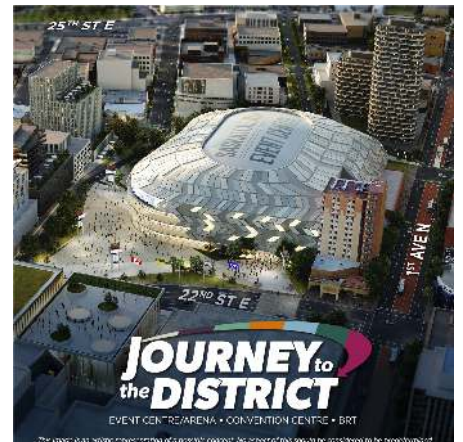
### INFORMATIONAL VIDEO

### OFFICE FOSTERS

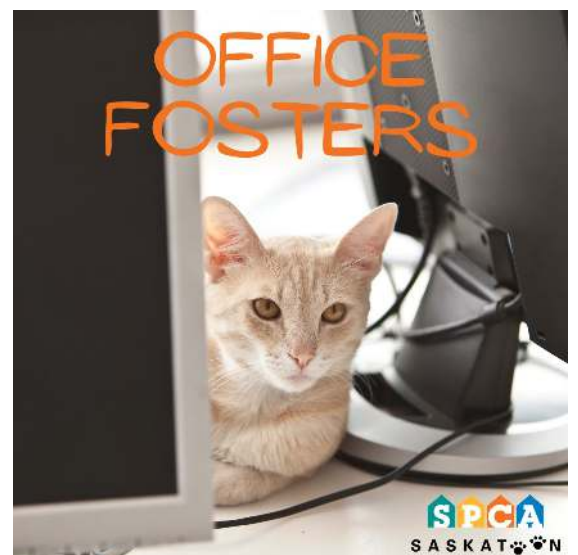

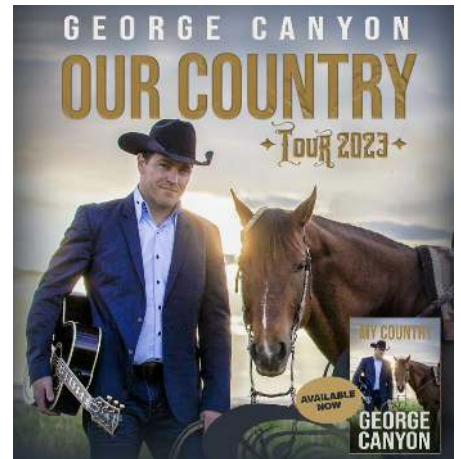


### GEORGE CANYON
