SASKATOON CITIZEN SURVEY RESULTS

Saskatoon City Administration completed a report on the public engagement results regarding the **Downtown Event and Entertainment District**. 3,134 people completed the City's survey, which aimed to see what Downtown features were most sought by the public.

Two information reports were presented to the Governance and Priorities Committee on December 12. The reports will help develop the vision for what Downtown Saskatoon could look like with the establishment of a successful **Downtown Event and Entertainment District**.

CALLS, OPPORTUNITIES + UPDATES

2024 ASSESSMENT NOTICES

Property owners and tax agents may now request the following throughout December 2023:

- Confirmation of your property's 2024 Assessed Value
- 2024 Property Valuation Cards or Field Sheets
- Explanation of changes (if there are any)

Starting January 2, 2024, the City will mail 2024 Assessment Notices to approximately 13,000 residential and commercial property owners, who since January 1, 2023, had a change to their property's assessment, tax status or ownership. [A 2024 Assessment Notice Guide](#) will accompany your 2024 Assessment Notice if you receive one.

- 2024 Assessment Roll, open for public inspection from January 2 to February 5, 2024.
- 30-day Assessment Review and Formal Appeal period, open from January 2 to February 5, 2024.

Applications are due January 1, 2024. Applications received after this deadline will be considered in the order that they are received, pending venue availability.

The **City of Saskatoon** has not planned any major construction in the Downtown area during the 2024 construction season (May – October). However, this situation may change and if it does, the City will do their best to work with you and accommodate your needs while also rehabilitating any critical infrastructure.

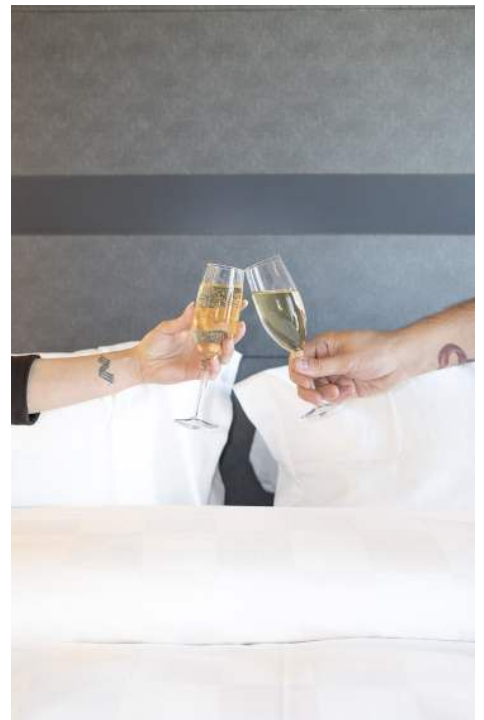
