PARKING RATES + FINES HAVE BEEN RAISED FOR 2024

The hourly rate at the City's metres has increased from \$2.00 to \$2.50 and fines have risen from \$30 to \$35. Unpaid tickets have additionally risen from \$50 to \$60 when not paid within 10 days.

CALLS, OPPORTUNITIES + UPDATES

2024 ASSESSMENT NOTICES

Property owners and tax agents may now request the following throughout December 2023:

- Confirmation of your property's 2024 Assessed Value
- 2024 Property Valuation Cards or Field Sheets
- Explanation of changes (if there are any)

Starting January 2, 2024, the City will mail 2024 Assessment Notices to approximately 13,000 residential and commercial property owners, who since January 1, 2023, **had a change to their property's assessment, tax status or ownership.** [A 2024 Assessment Notice Guide](#) will accompany your 2024 Assessment Notice if you receive one.

- 2024 Assessment Roll, open for public inspection from January 2 to February 5, 2024.
- 30-day Assessment Review and Formal Appeal period, open from January 2 to February 5, 2024.
