LIVE LOCAL JAZZ AT MIDTOWN

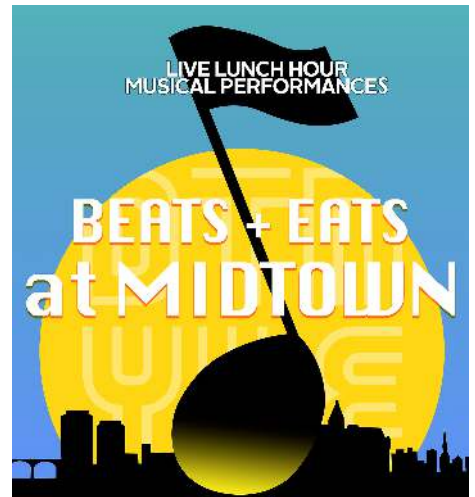
Join us for some **Live Local Jazz!** Every Thursday for the month of April.

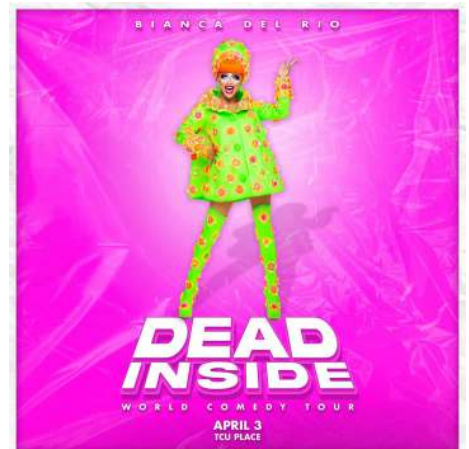

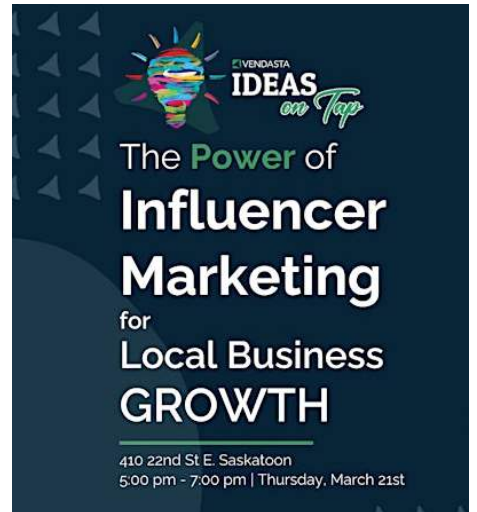
