The **City of Saskatoon** is expanding the **Pay Parking** within the Warehouse District and Central Industrial area of the Downtown District.

Signage and the flex pay stations are to be installed and in effect by July 15, 2024.

FAÇADE AND SECURITY GRANT

The **Downtown Saskatoon Business Façade and Security Grant** program is still available for those interested in improving their building.

Eligible businesses can receive up to a 50% reimbursement to a maximum of \$1,000 to complete exterior improvements such as building facades, signage, murals, architectural features, siding, lighting, awnings, security cameras, or related security improvements.

- Spadina Cr loop that goes under the University Bridge
- Spadina Cr, from 23rd - 25th Sts E
- 24th St E, from Spadina Cr to 4th Ave N
- 4th Ave N, from 24th St E to 22nd St E
- 22nd St E, from 4th Ave to 1st Ave N
- 1st Ave, from 22nd St E to 20th St E
- 22nd St EB at Pacific Ave
- 20th St E, from 1st Ave to 4th Ave S
- Midtown South Parking lot entrance/exit onto 20th St E (vehicles can go underground to the north lot exits)
- 3rd Ave S, from 21st St E to 19th St E
