Beginning in April, the Broadway Bridge, including the multi-use pathways on both sides, will fully close for approximately seven months (exact timelines to be determined). The plan is for 112 units, with a range of wraparound services to help with education, employment and community engagement.

The B6 – Downtown Commercial District, covering most of Downtown, allows diverse, high-density land uses and building types. The City has been working to update B6 to reflect current practices, ensure quality, align with strategic goals, and encourage development. In addition, proposed changes to MX2 – Downtown Warehouse Mixed Use District along with regulations for surface parking throughout Downtown, including in the B6 District, MX2 District, and M4 District will be presented.

The City of Saskatoon is also pleased to announce their new edition of the <u>Business Start Up</u> <u>Guide</u> is now available. The guide provides information on all orders of government with a shift to general information and external links. This ensures the information remains relevant in a rapidly changing regulatory and tax environment.

Do you know someone who has left a lasting legacy on the Downtown district? If so, we encourage you to nominate them for LEGENDS DOWNTOWN.


