DOWNTOWN HAPPENINGS

BROADWAY BRIDGE PROJECT UPDATES

Beginning in early May, the Broadway Bridge, including pedestrian walkways on each side, will be fully closed until fall 2025.

The upcoming construction project will include improvements to arches, railings and pathways, deck repairs, new barriers, and more. The project will also include a reconfiguring of the 4th Ave S and 19th St E intersection. This reconfiguration will create a more pedestrian-friendly intersection and see the removal of the current traffic island located in the middle area.

Full Closures During Construction are the Following.

- Broadway Bridge (including multi-use pathways on both sides)
- Broadway Avenue from Saskatchewan Crescent East to 20th Street East
- 19th Street East from 3rd Avenue South to Broadway Avenue
- 4th Avenue South from 19th Street East to 20th Street East

The new Saskatoon Downtown temporary **emergency shelter is set to open April 1st.** The shelter will have room for 30 to 40 beds, admission will be on a first-come, first-served basis, and it will operate 24 hours a day, seven days a week. Each person staying at the new shelter will be screened before entering, and safety measures include cameras inside and outside the building.
