DOWNTOWN HAPPENINGS

BROADWAY BRIDGE CONSTRUCTION PROJECT

Beginning in April, the Broadway Bridge, including pedestrian walkways on each side, will be fully closed for the summer season.

The construction will include improvements to arches, railings and pathways, deck repairs, new barriers, and more. The project will also include a reconfiguring of the 4th Ave S and 19th St E intersection. This reconfiguration will create a more pedestrian-friendly intersection and see the removal of the current traffic island located in the middle area.

Pedestrian access via the Meewasin Trail will be maintained through scaffolding tunnels under the Bridge and both Friendship Park and the boat launch will still be accessible and open. Spadina Crescent between 20th St E and 3rd Avenue will, however, be closed to vehicle traffic.

Full Closures During Construction are the Following.

- Broadway Bridge (including multi-use pathways on both sides)
- Broadway Avenue from Saskatchewan Crescent East to 20th Street East
- 19th Street East from 3rd Avenue South to Broadway Avenue
- 4th Avenue South from 19th Street East to 20th Street East

Work throughout the project will be taking place between 7am and 7pm, some situations may arise where work takes place outside of these hours, but contractors will adhere to City bylaws.

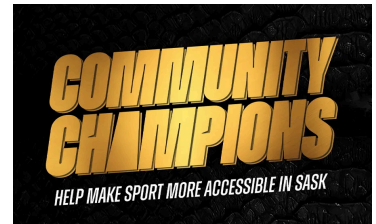
COMMUNITY CHAMPIONS PROGRAM
